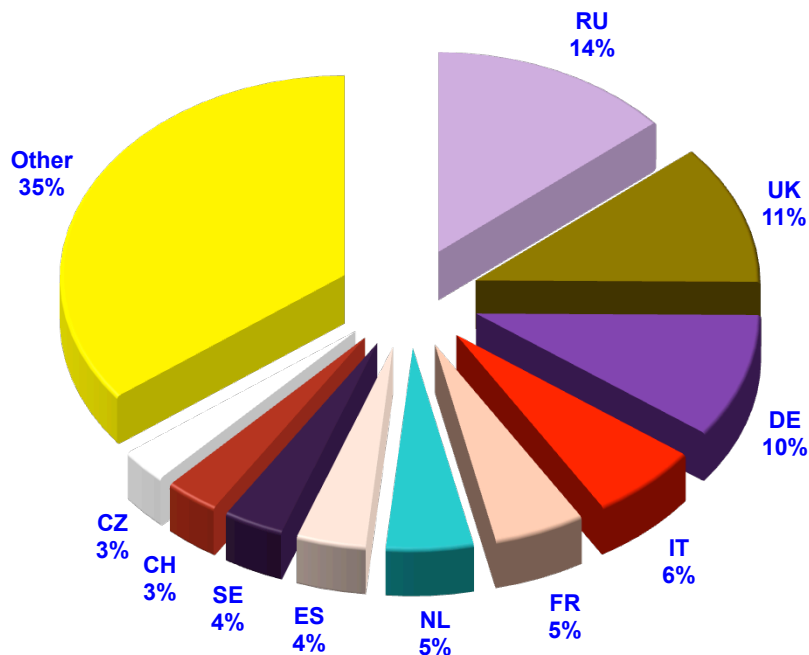

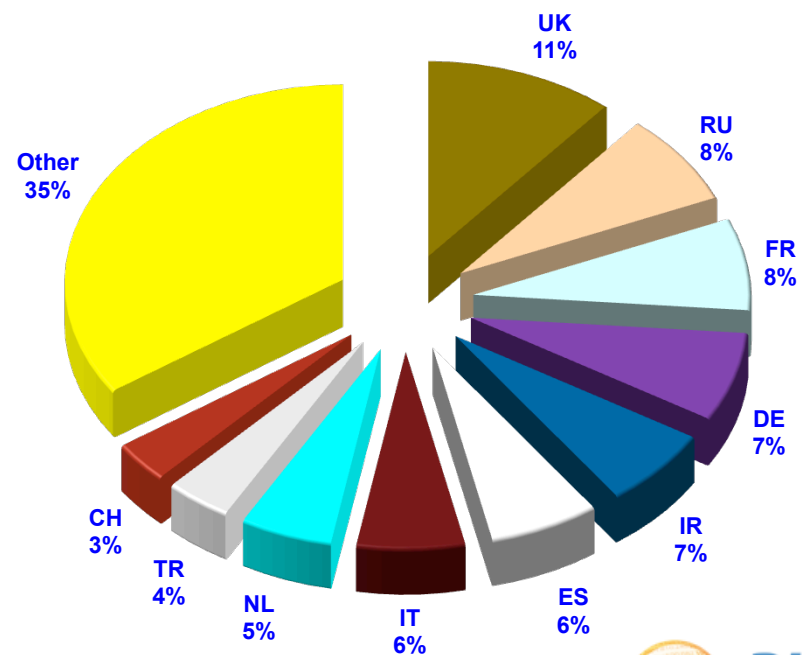
RIPE NCC member information

Total members per country 2011



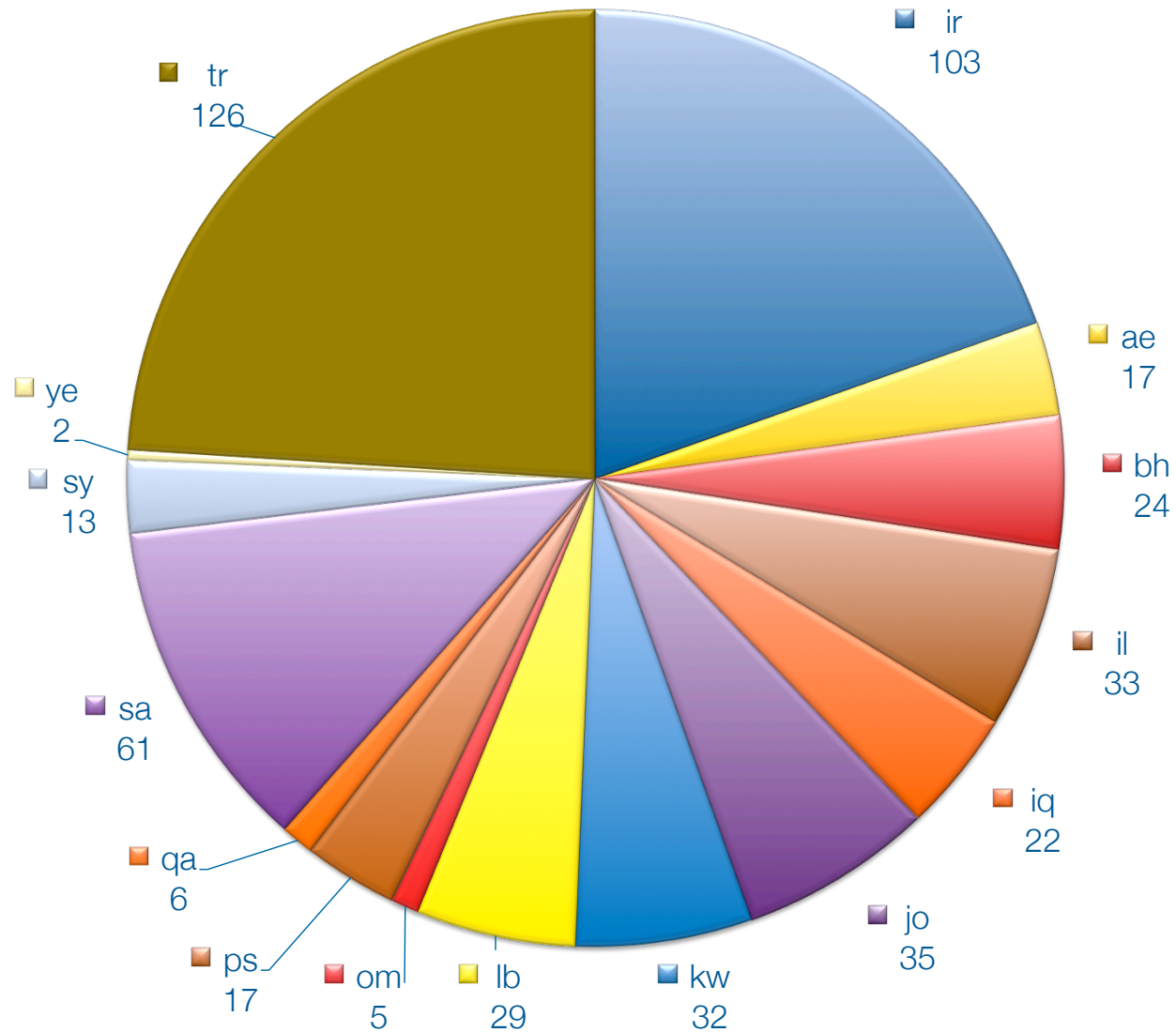
Applications per country 2011



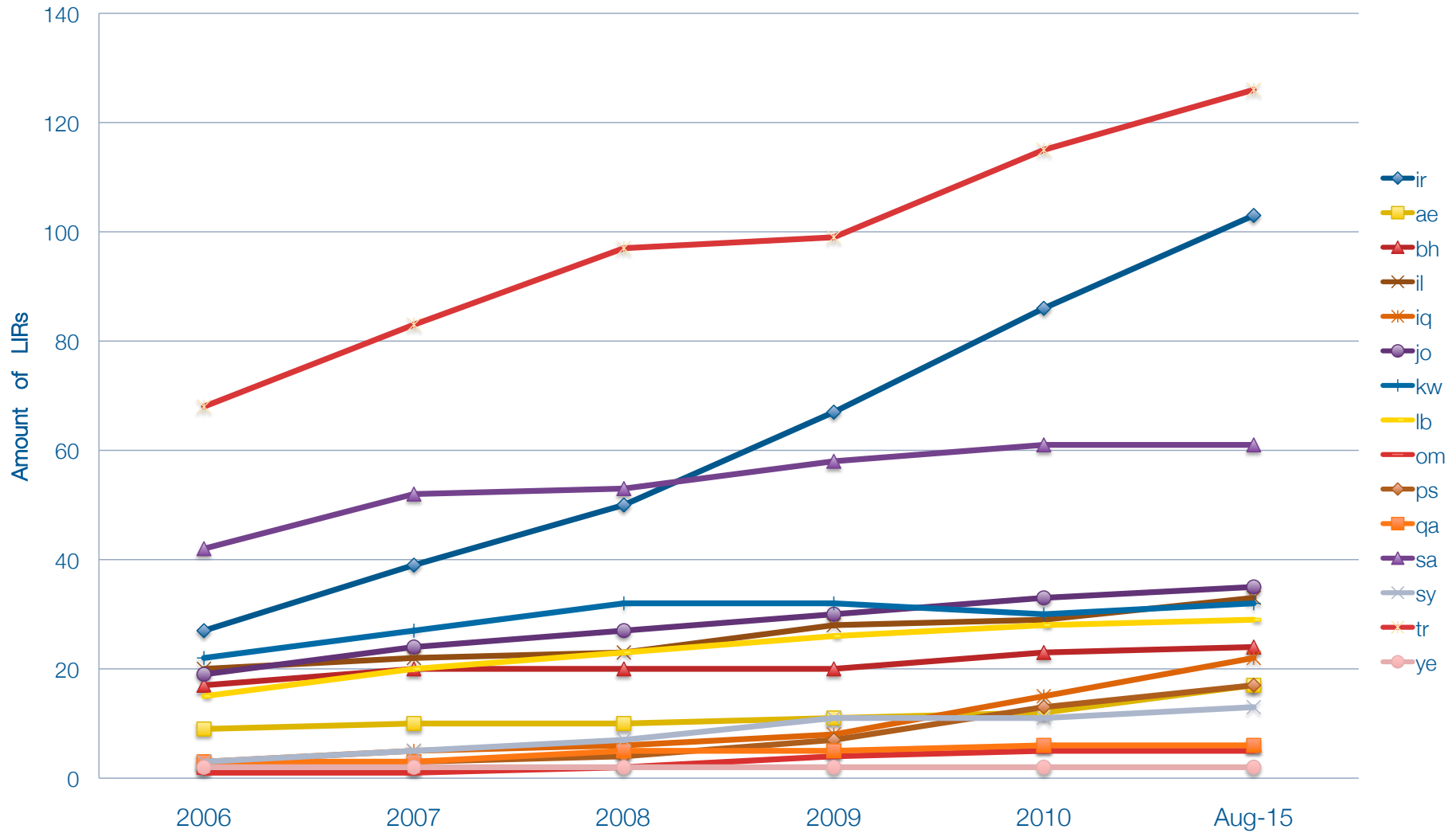
Middle East member information 2011

Historic development 2006–2011



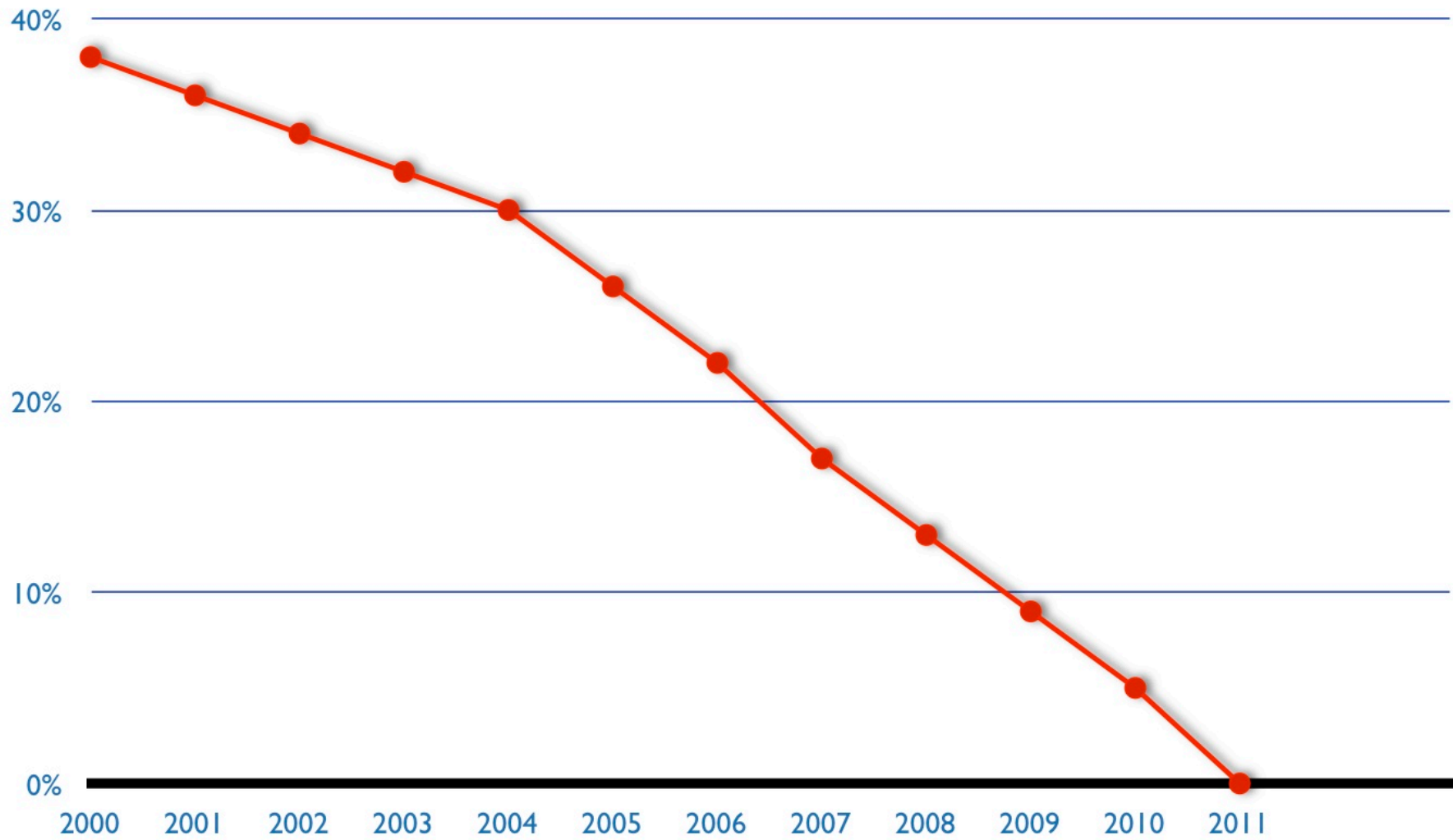

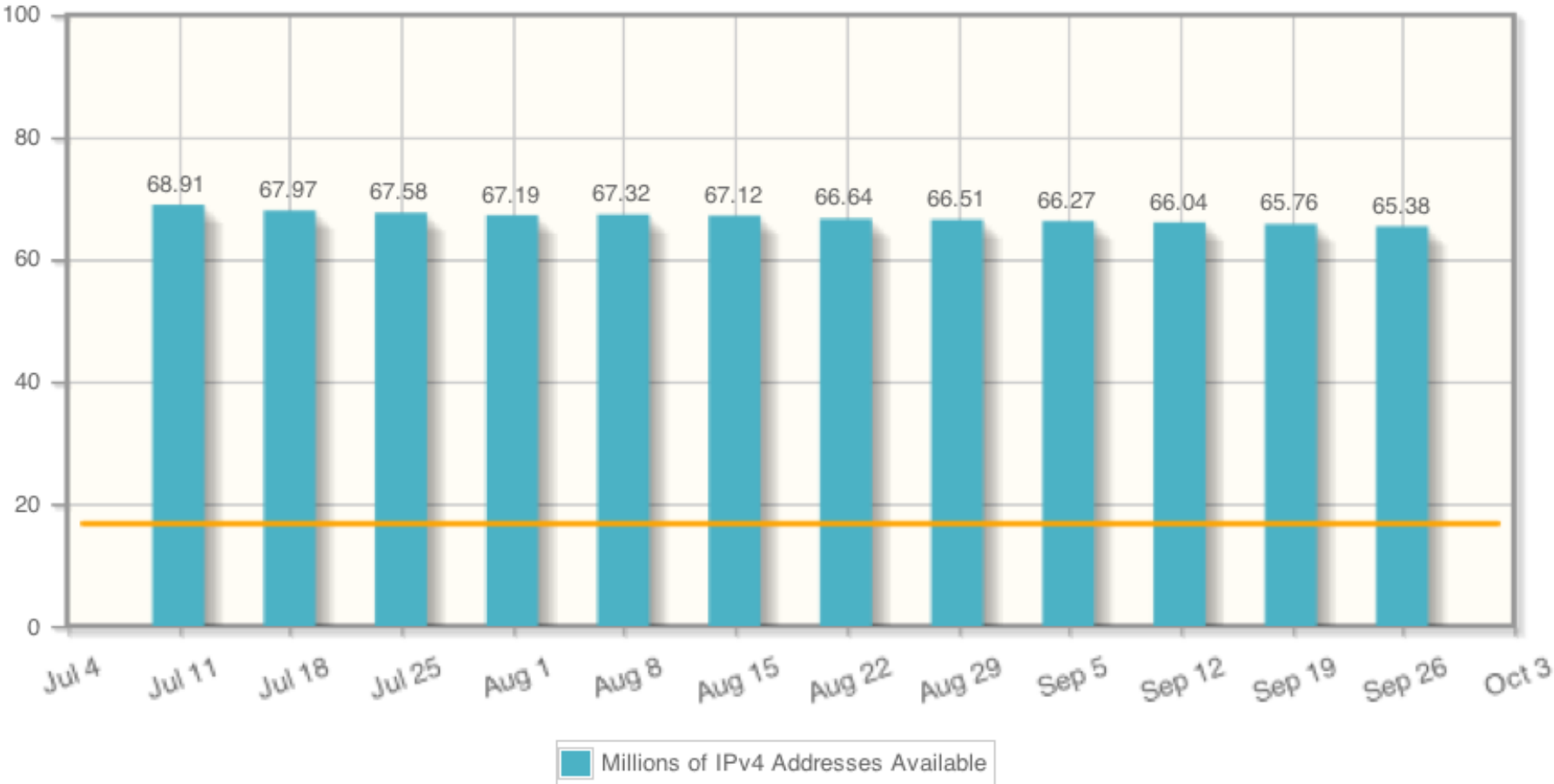

IPv4 Address Pool – NOW



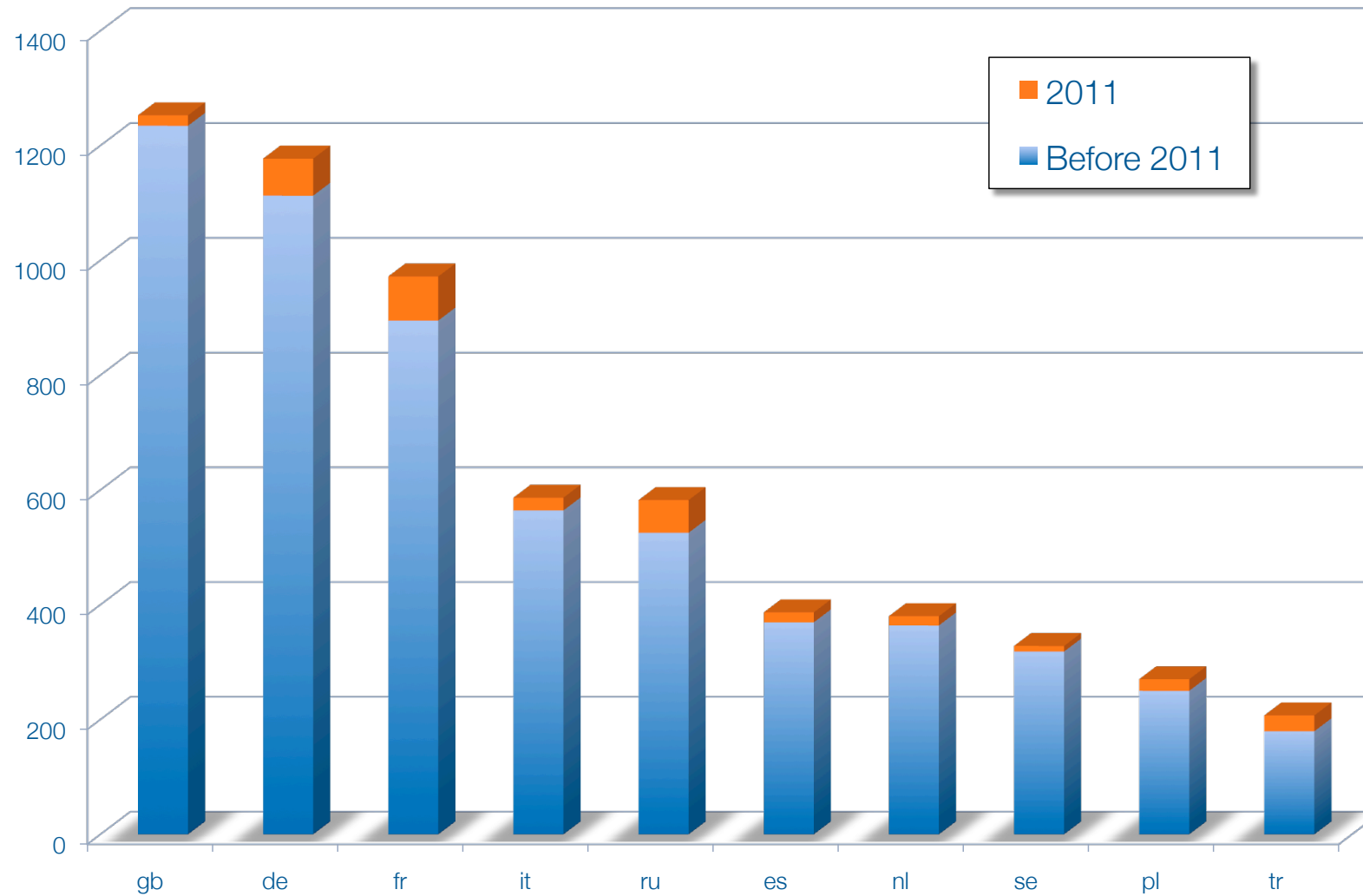
Run Out Fairly (of IPv4)

- Gradually reduced allocation / assignment periods
- Needs for “Entire Period” of up to...
 - 12 months (January 2010)
 - 9 months (July 2010)
 - 6 months (January 2011)
 - **3 months (July 2011)**
- 50% has to be used up by half-period

Results:

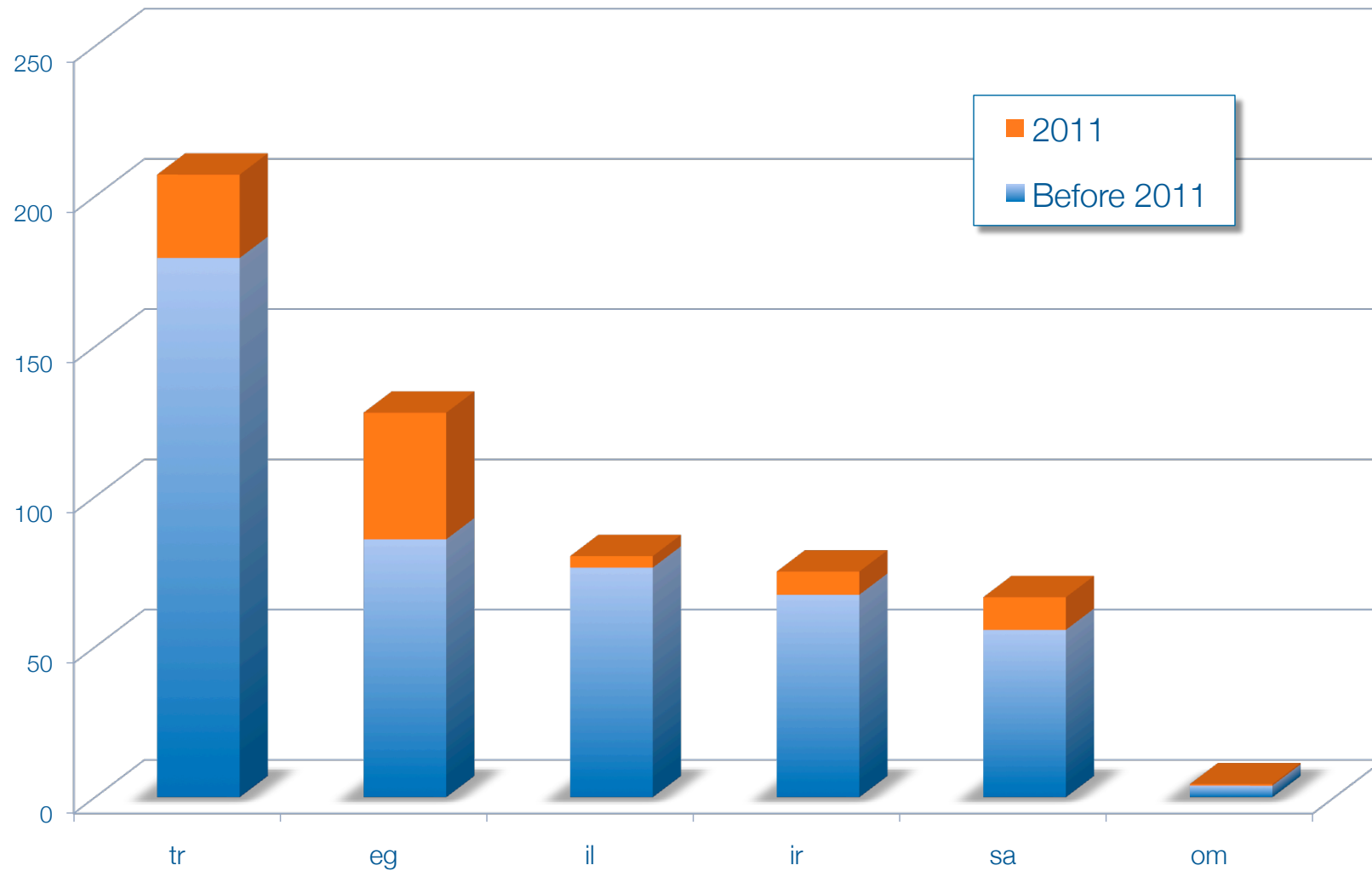
- Assignment sizes became smaller
- Assignment requests are being made more frequently

IPv4 Address space per country



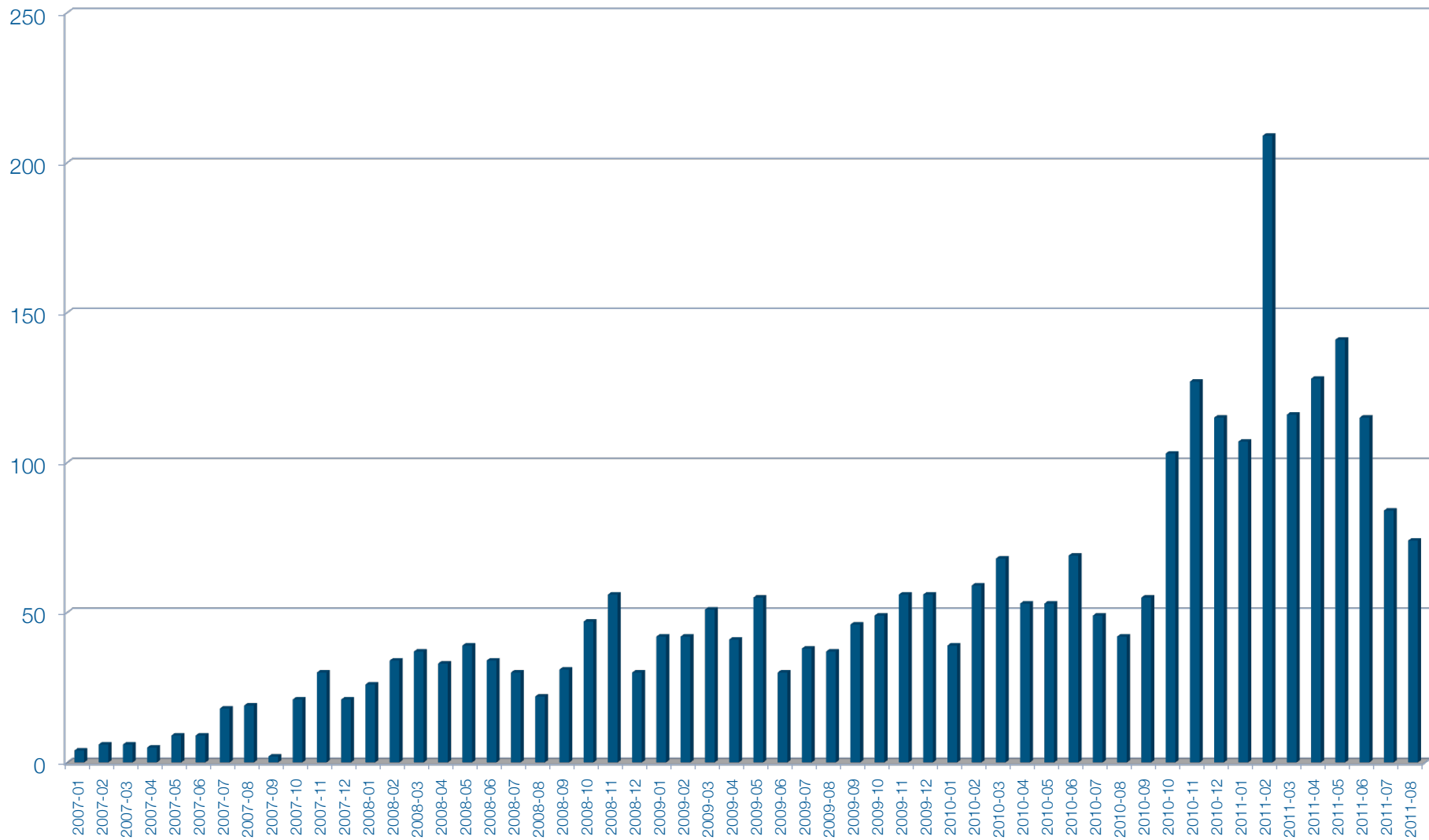

IPv4 – Regional statistics

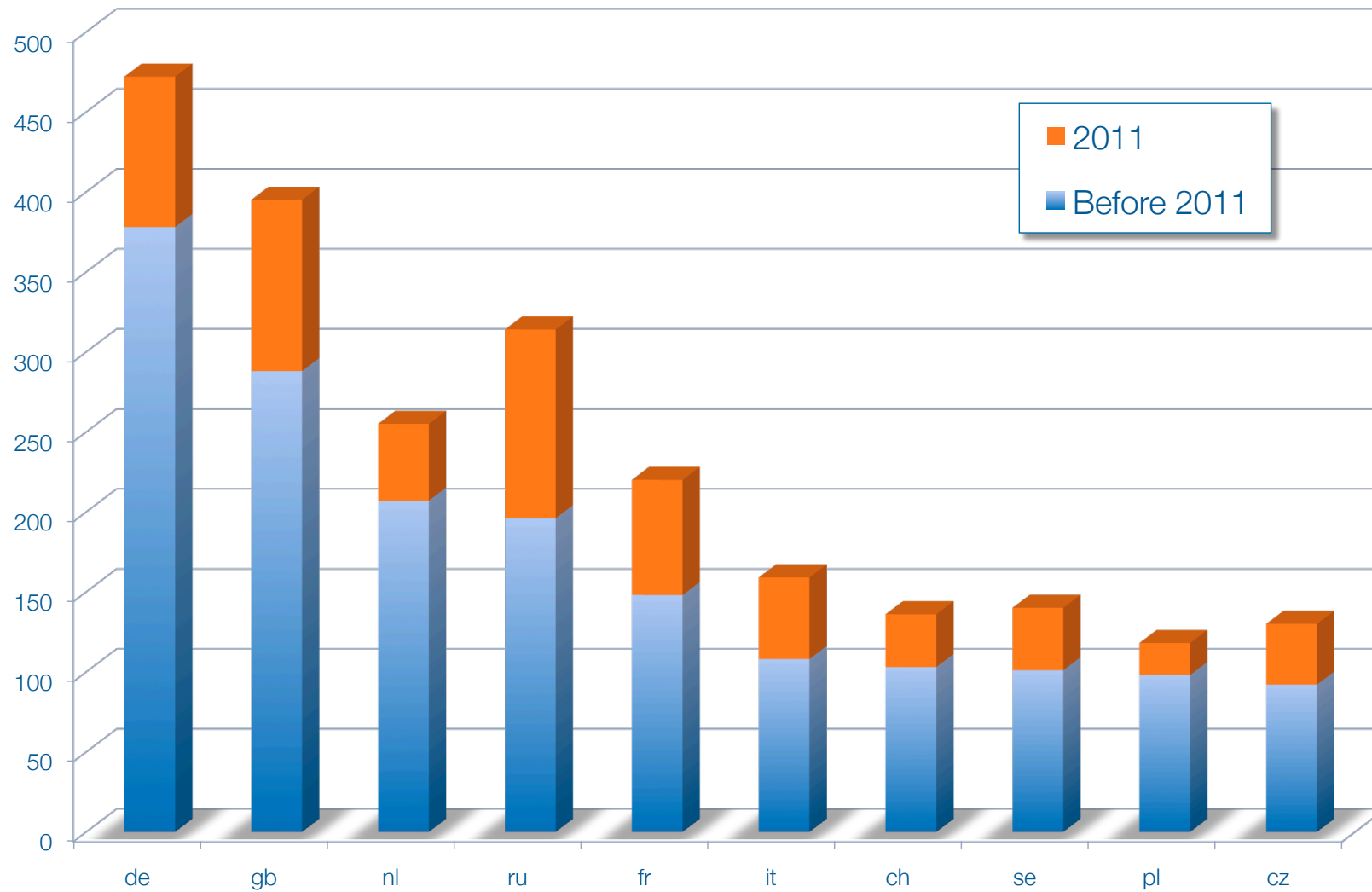

IPv6 – Allocations per month

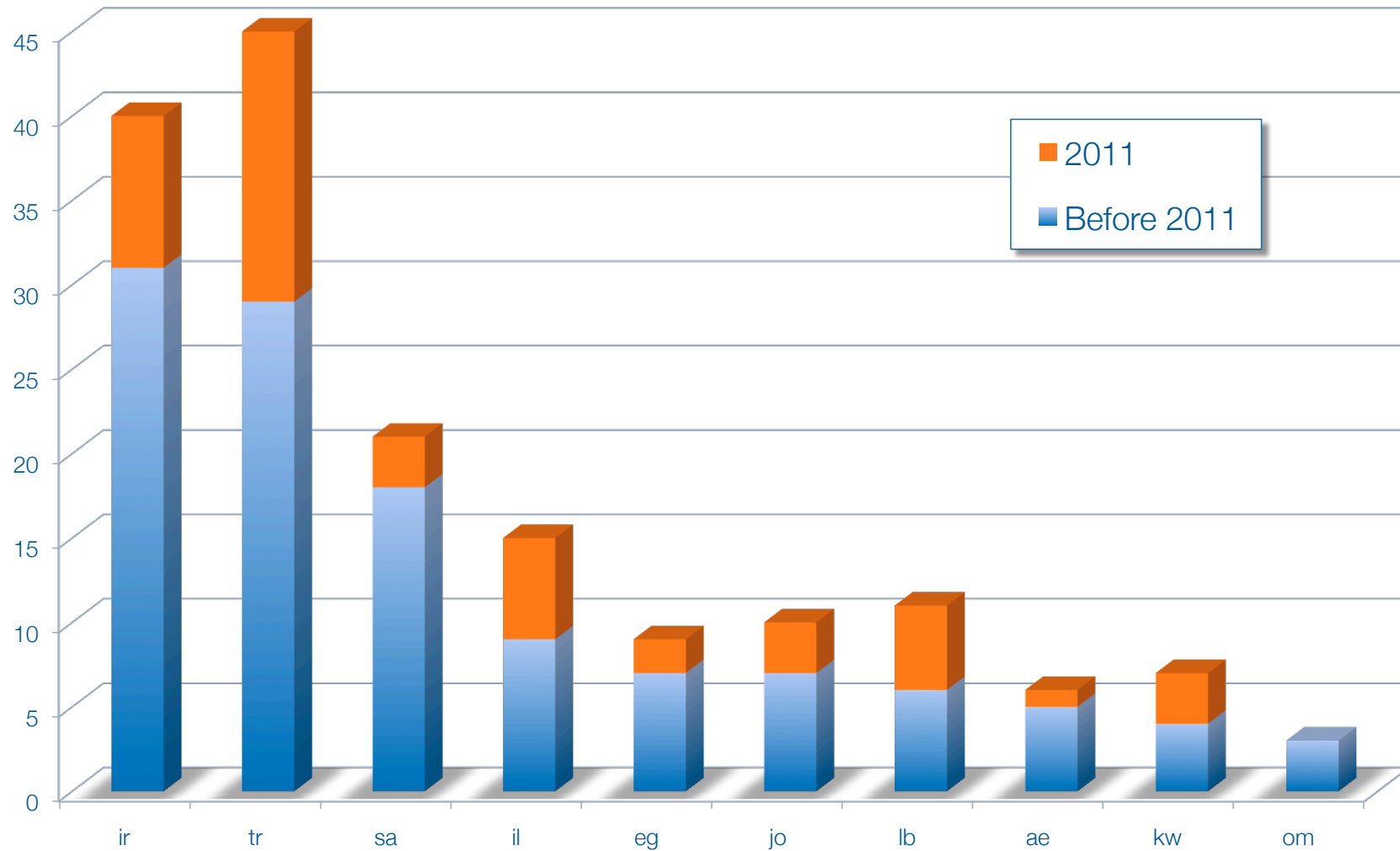


IPv6 Allocations per country



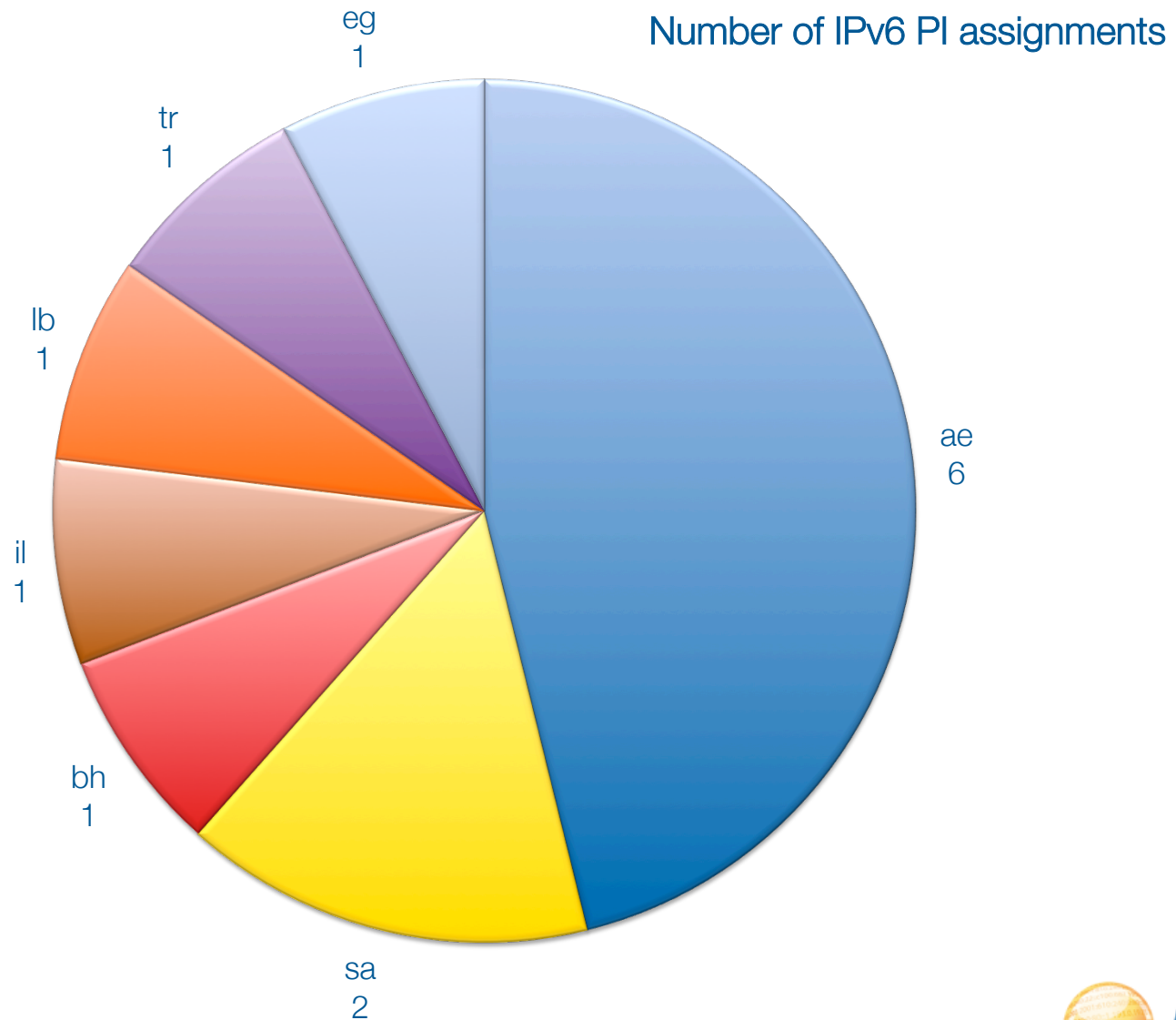
Number of allocations

IPv6 – Regional statistics

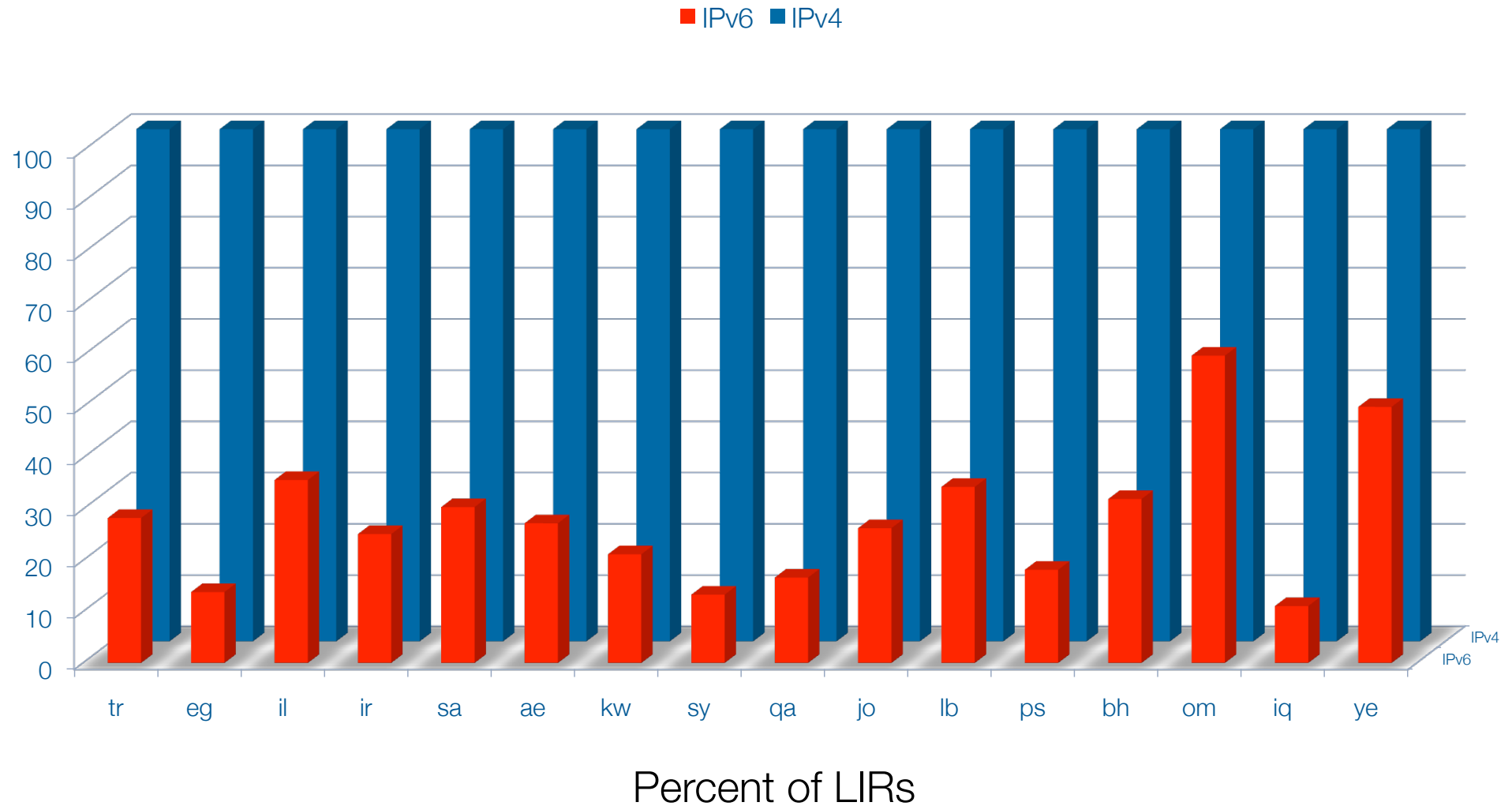

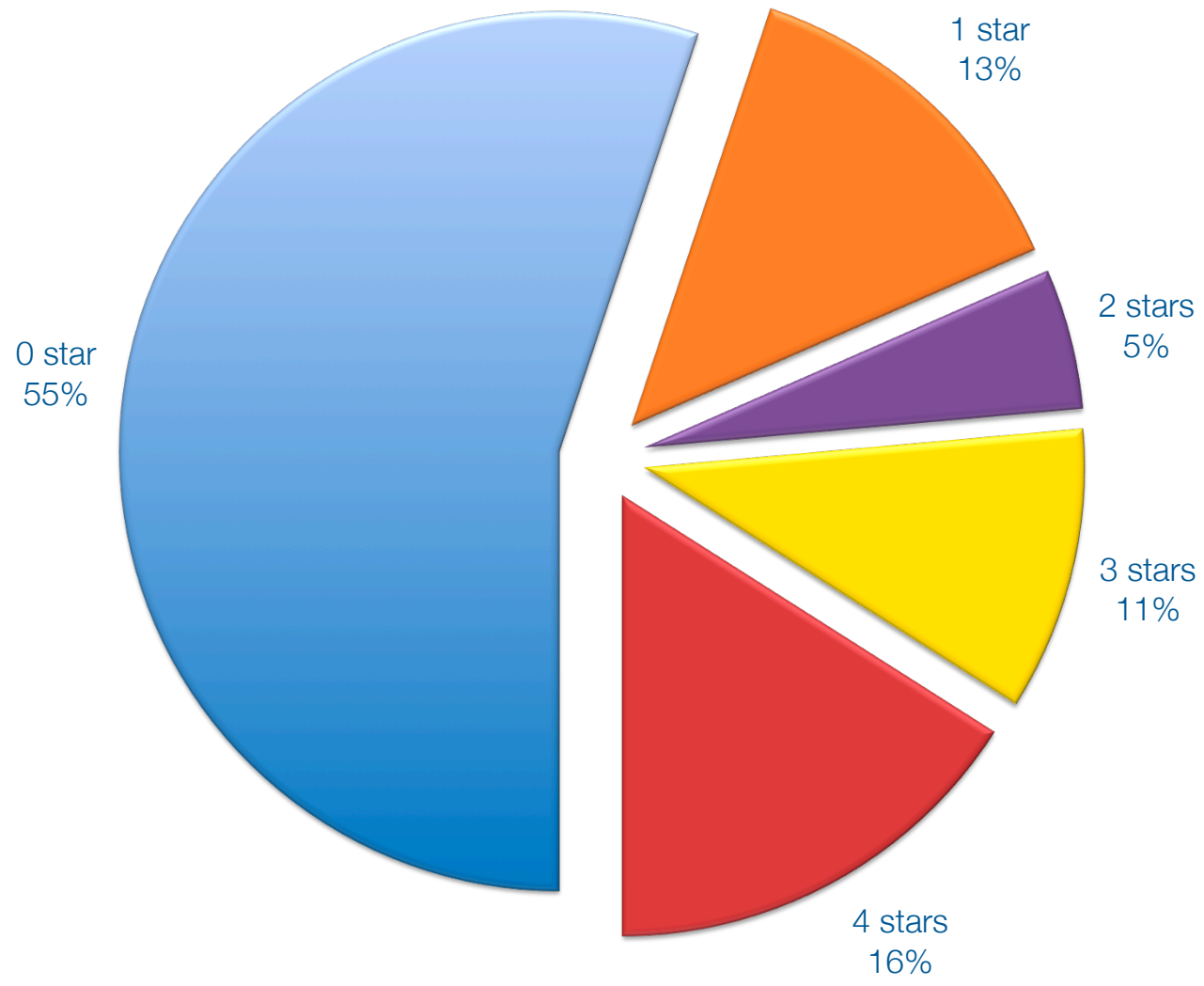
IPv6 PI assignments – Regional statistics



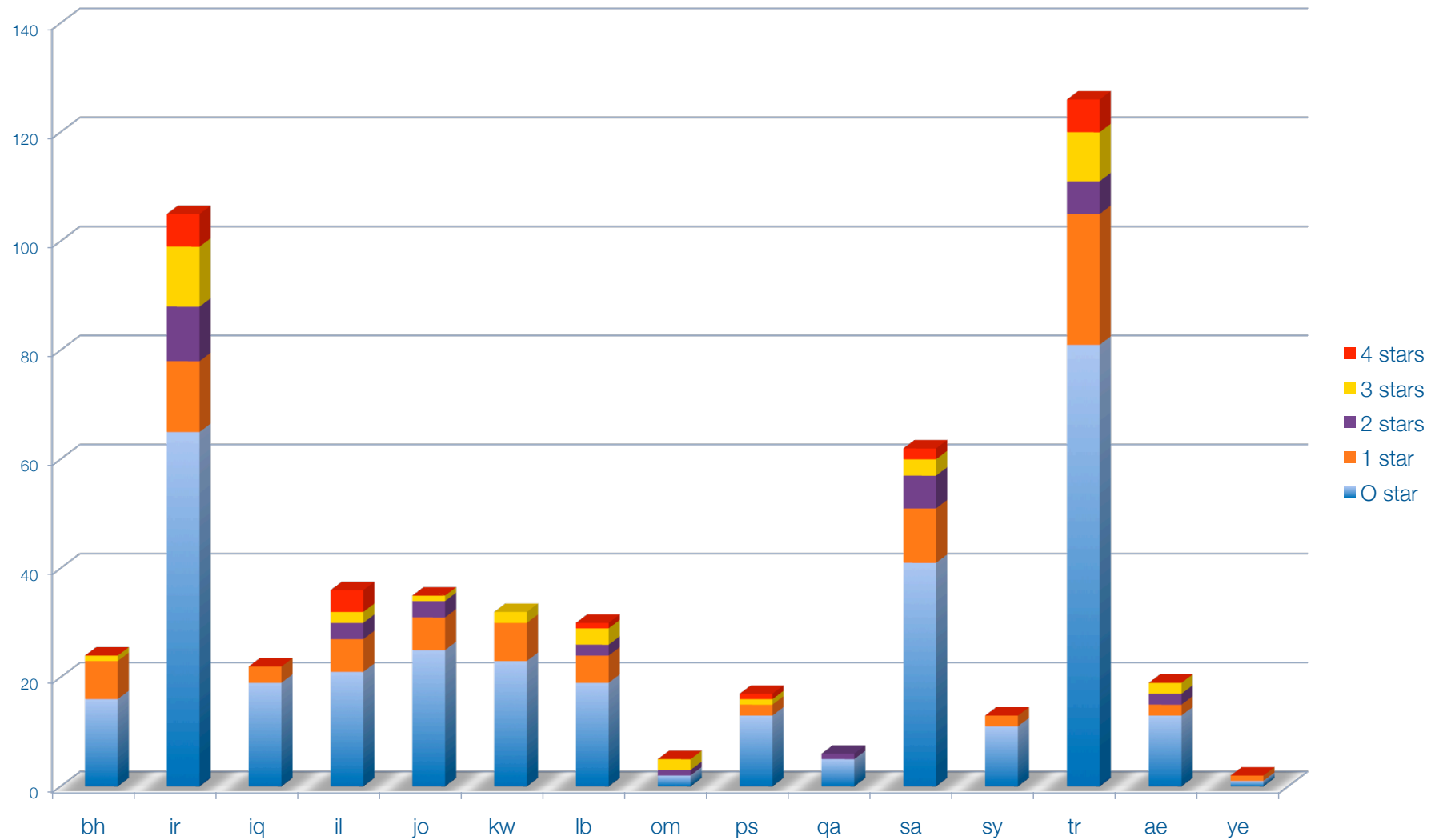
IPv4 vs IPv6 – Regional Statistics
