



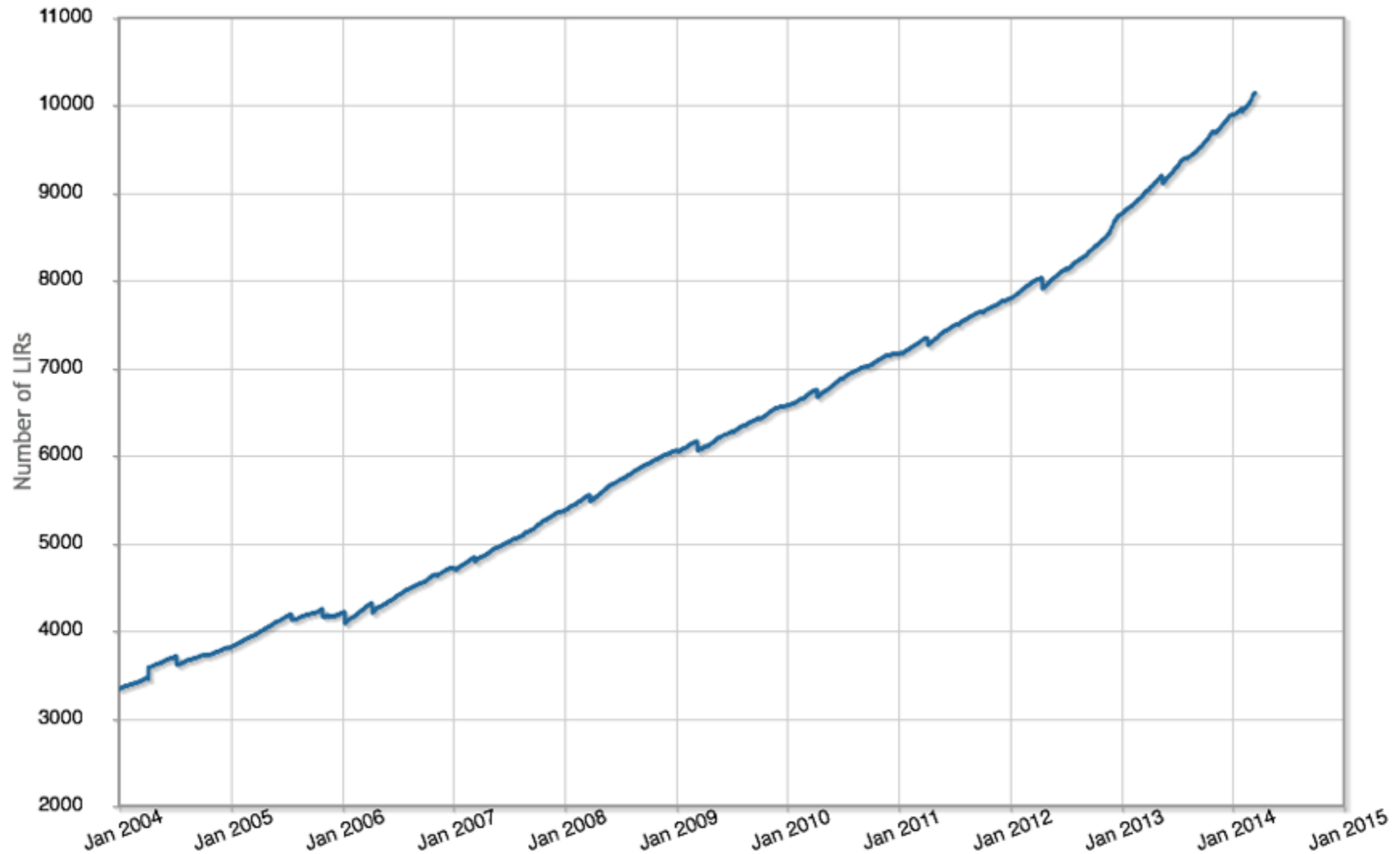

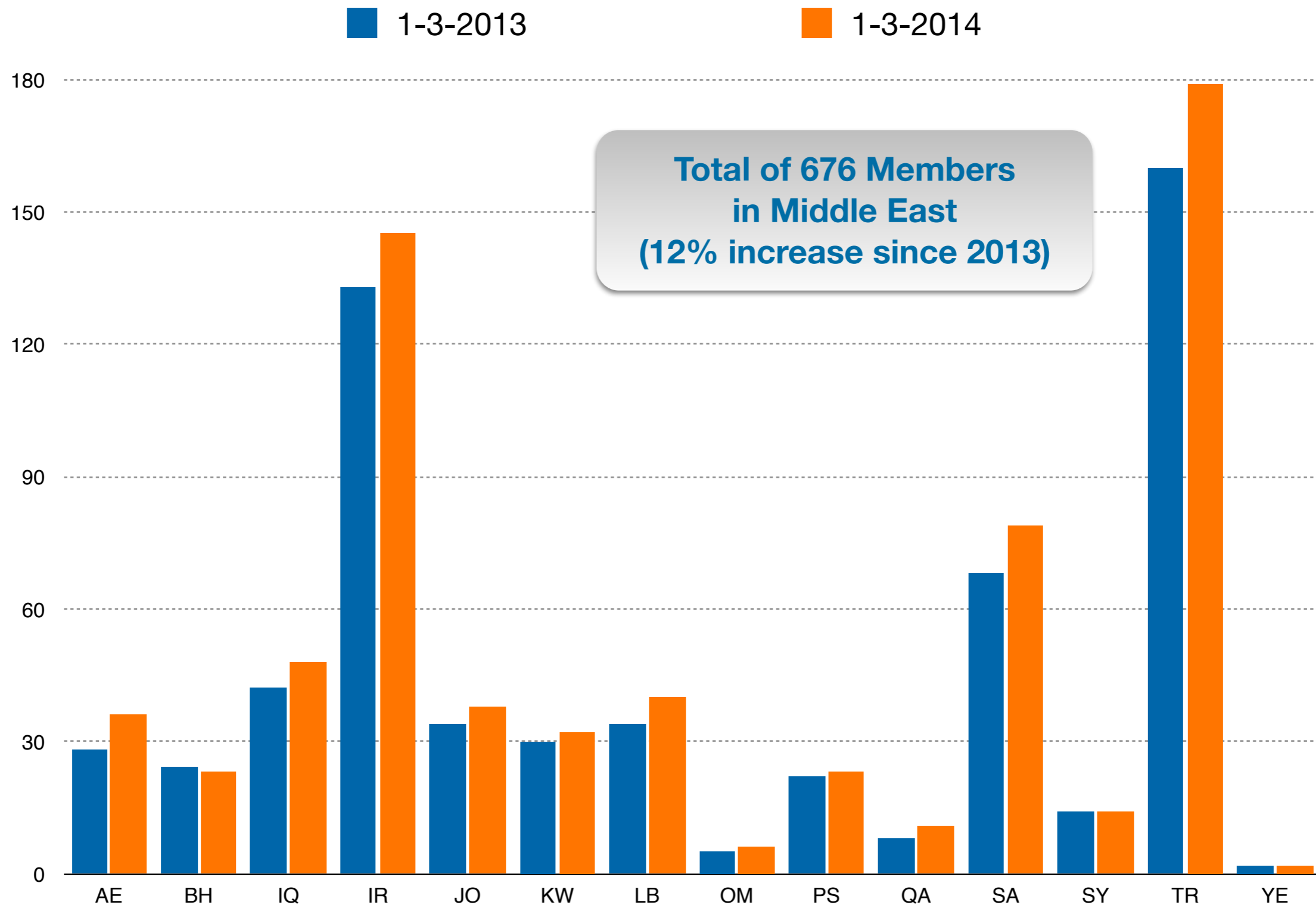
- More organisations becoming a member

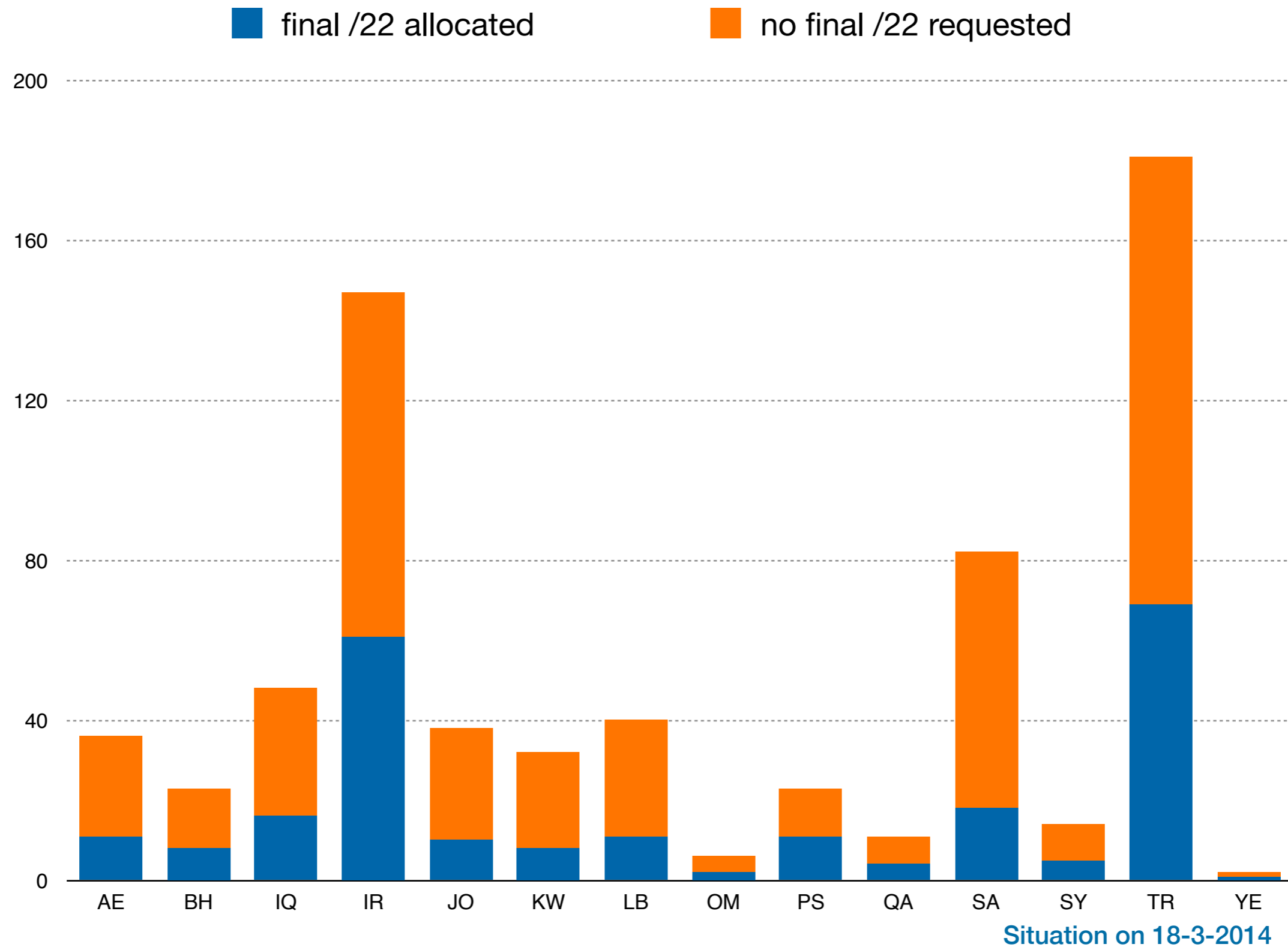
Regional Membership Increasing



- Established a Dubai office in 2011
- Time has come to expand our presence
- Hired two Arab employees to work from Dubai
 - Sandra Gijzen relocated
- Opened a new (bigger) office in Media City
 - Better contact with the Arab community
 - Operations remain in Amsterdam

- Remember we still have some IPv4 addresses left
 - Every member can get 1,024 addresses (/22)
 - Block reserved for Internet Exchange Points
- Number of transfers increasing
- Policy changes reduce bureaucracy and make obtaining IPv4 addresses easier
 - Less paperwork to prove you need addresses

Members With and Without /22



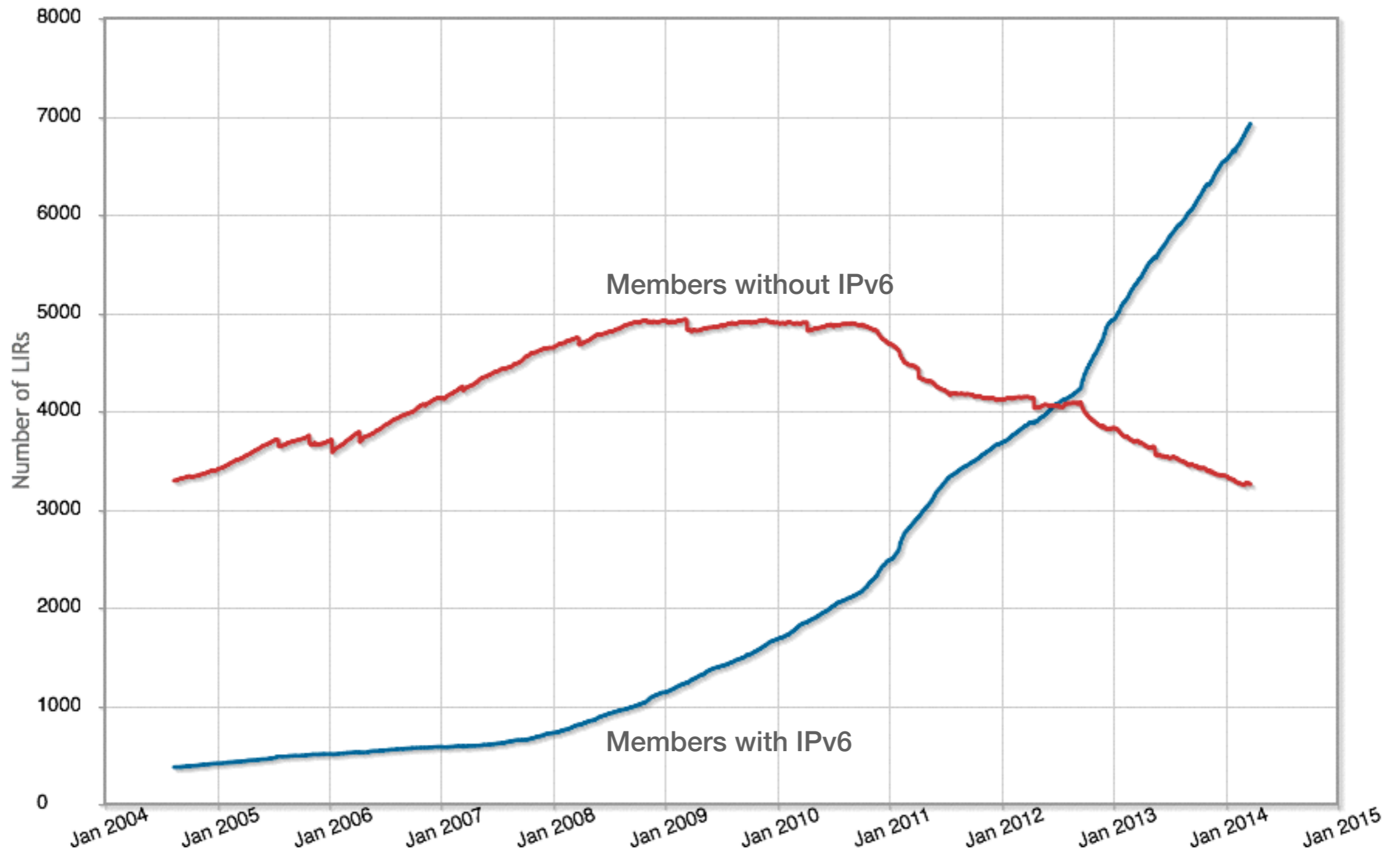
- IPv4 addresses are becoming more valuable
- Criminals try very sophisticated methods to obtain control over unused address blocks
 - Faking registration and identity papers
 - Faking entire websites and domains
- RIPE NCC has to do more thorough checks
 - Unfortunately it can take extra time in processing your requests
 - Please cooperate in supplying the required documents

- Hijacks often target address blocks with outdated contact details
- Make sure your contact persons and company details are up-to-date
 - Check the LIR Portal and update contacts
 - Verify all entries in RIPE Database are correct
 - Process any changes right away
- RIPE NCC relies on this information to validate any requested changes
 - Contact us if you need assistance updating your details

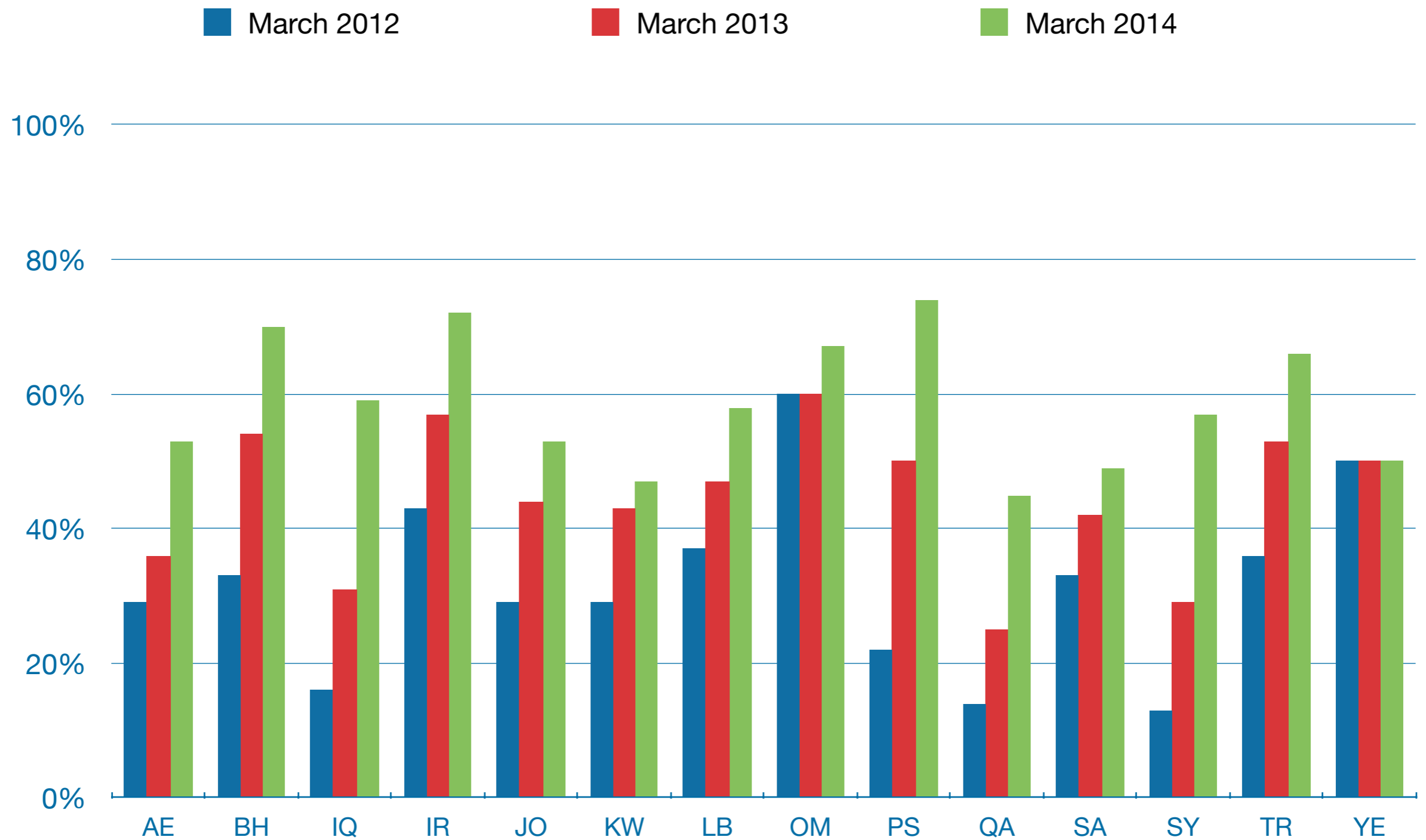
- Available for some time now
 - Allows direct contact with Customer Service
 - Gradually adding departments and capacity
- Will be integrated with SSO and LIR Portal
 - Will add user validation and authorisation
 - Allows to add Registration Services (IPRA)
 - Discuss resource requests directly with a colleague
