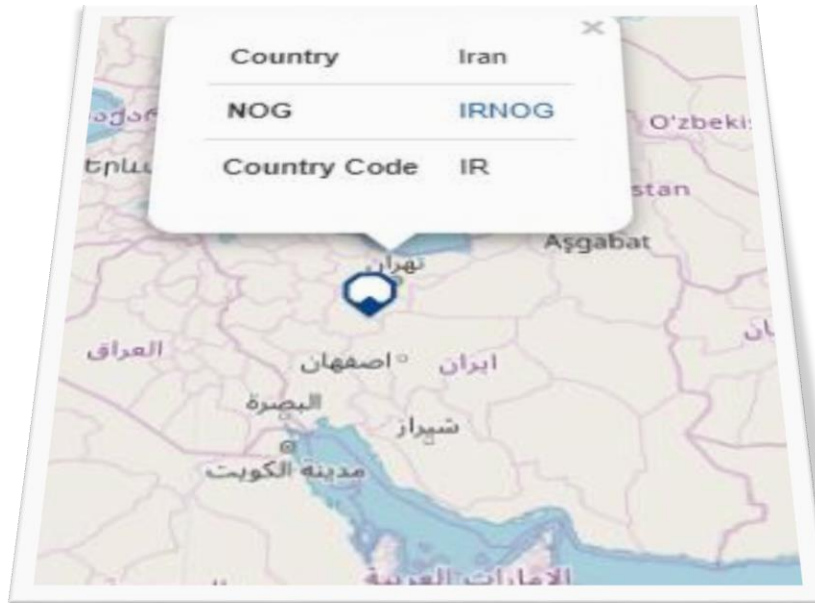

The Internet Community In Iran

- ▶ The local technical community in Iran was not organized in the form of a network operators forum or similar group before 2014.
- ▶ To provide a neutral platform for the community to come together, the RIPE NCC organized a RIPE NCC Regional Meeting in Iran which was held on 18 November 2014.
- ▶ Some time after the regional meeting in Tehran, the RIPE NCC arranged a member lunch with Iranian LIRs and this led to the creation of a [Persian-LIR](#) mailing list on 2015.
- ▶ In 2016 the meeting held under the title "[Independent Event of Iranian LIRs](#)" and was attended by 60 RIPE NCC members, at the end, some active members got together to create a team to set up a local Network Operators Group called [IRNOG](#).

The IRNOG-1 Meeting

- ▶ After many calls during the last year, the IRNOG PC decided to organize an event on 24 May 2017:
 - Venue: Tehran
 - Number of registered participants: < 200
 - Number of checked in participants: 130
 - Duration: 1 day
 - Number of presentation: 6
 - Number of sponsors: 3
 - Online streaming: Available

Feedbacks

- ▶ Followed by many positive news articles, tweets, reports and emails, IRNOG1 proved to be a very successful event in Iran.



The IRNOG Structure

- ▶ After the first meeting the PC decided for changing the structure according to all members ideas and suggestions and also call for selecting new volunteers as PC members.
- ▶ IRNOG Constitution:
 - 3 working groups: technical, public relation and event planning.
 - Number of PC members: 9 (1 as a secretary)
 - Working language: Farsi
 - and ...
- ▶ PC member selecting method:
 - Online election system
 - 10 candidates
 - 144 votes

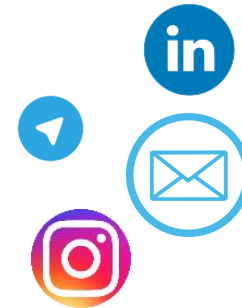
